AGE OF USE

The City of Waupun Community Center strives to provide a safe and supervised environment for all ages. Our facility offers a variety of activities and services geared towards health and recreation. However, our facility is not a daycare or care facility. Youth under 12 years of age must be attending a scheduled Waupun Community Center activity/event and under the direct supervision of a caregiver. Active older adults are welcome to bring an attendant or caregiver with them in order to enjoy services and programs. Participants without a caregiver must be independent and able to care for their own personal needs. VISION & MISSION

Waupun Community Center Mission: The Waupun Community Center provides recreation; health, social, and educational programs and services through partnerships and programming to help residents of all ages live well.

In the event of inclement/severe weather, the Waupun Community Center shall close with or without notice. If the Waupun Area School District has a delayed start due to bad weather, the Waupun Community Center early morning activities will be canceled. If the Waupun Area School District closes early or cancels after school activities, the Waupun Community Center will close accordingly, and all afternoon and evening activities will be canceled. 
