### FREE COVID-19 MOBILE TESTING UNIT

Fond du Lac County Health Department is partnering with Accelerated Clinical Laboratories to offer <u>FREE COVID-</u><u>19 testing for all Fond du Lac County residents ages 2 and older</u>.

Accelerated Clinical Laboratories will be providing mobile COVID-19 testing onsite at:

- 1. The Fond du Lac County Fairgrounds on **Mondays, Thursdays & Fridays from 8AM -4:30PM**. (Walk In Only Cow Palace at 520 Fond du Lac Ave, Fond du Lac WI 54935)
- Alliance Laundry Systems on Tuesdays from 10am-4pm (Drive thru only at 119 Shepard Street Ripon, WI 54971). Testing is in the parking lot behind the corporate office, enter on Hall Street near the train tracks.

<u>Residents do not need to be experiencing symptoms to be tested</u>. <u>No appointment, insurance, or identification</u> <u>required</u>. PCR test only – results usually within 1-2 days.

Testing Schedule: At this time, there is no set end date for the mobile testing.

To qualify your pharmacist must agree, and you must pay the cost of your medications (if any) over the telephone or internet. But Waupun Taxi will not add on any extra charge for the delivery. Call your pharmacist.

### AFFORDABLE TRANSPORTATION AVAILABLE FOR AGE 60+:

We can take you anywhere within the city limits of Waupun with the exception of the laundromat or pet-related places. We can take you to doctor appointments, hair appointments, grocery shopping, to restaurants, to banks, to the library, to anywhere! Transportation for ages 60+ within the city limits of Waupun. Multiple stops can be scheduled in 15-minute or more increments. Riders must be able to navigate two steps safely to board the vehicle. Van can seat up to nine passengers. Cost: \$1 each stop. Rides must be scheduled the day before by noon by calling 324-7930. Rides can be scheduled as early as 9AM. The last non-medical ride is at 2PM and the last medical ride appointment is at 3PM.
